The next phase of Sysco's implementation of Workday is underway. We have concluded design workshops for Core HCM and Recruiting and are in the final stages of defining how we will leverage new technology in our Time and Payroll environments. This decision-making process, combined with our next Design Workshops, will prepare us for new U.S. Time and Payroll environments effective in June of 2020.

You've been selected to be part of the Design Workshops dedicated to Time and Payroll. You will represent your portion of the business in discussions and decision making including, where necessary, defining consistent processes and practices that are needed to fully use our new technology. We may also ask for your future help in testing, data validation, change management and end-user training.
